## Entrance on King Street East

### SEMI-CIRCULAR GARDEN

- Ornamental Grasses
- Bands of Coleus

### THE TWO ANGULAR BEDS ON EITHER SIDE OF THE PATHWAY NORTH FROM KING STREET

#### Inside row:

- Boxwood (12 small clumps)
- Roses Fuschia (8 Standards)

#### Outside row, small flowering shrubs:

- Hypericum
- Daphne Cneorum
- Deutzia Gracius

#### In between inside and outside rows, annuals:

- Blue Lobelia
- Fibrous Begonia white
- Fibrous Begonia pink
- Petunia Red
- Autumn Salvia Red

## Top gate

- Tall, medium, low marigolds

## Southwest Quadrant

### Hedge on west and south:

- Regel's Privet
- Vinca Minor groundcover

### A hedge of flowering shrubs:

- Spirea Van Houttei
- Hydrangea
- Arboreslenys
- Grandi Flora
- Hibiscus

- Syriacus Red
- Philadelphus
- Vignalis Purity
- Lily of the Valley groundcover

### A small bed towards centre with:

- Thyme
- Mignonette
- Heliotrope Dracena

### A middle bed with mixed annual and perennials:

- Canna
- Geraniums
- Petunias
- Sweet Alyssum edging

## Southeast Quadrant

### Upper perennial bed with:

- Stachys Lanata
- Achillea Tomentosa
- Dianthus Coricus
- Hosta Plantaginea
- Veronica Incana
- Hermerocallis yellow orange
- Althea white red

### Edged with:

- Sweet Alyssum
- Myotis Scorpioides

## Northeast Quadrant

### Hedge on east – 4-5' Regel's Privet

### South bed, perennials:

- Althea Sp. Single flowers
- Paeonia Lactiflora singles
- Lavandula Officinalis "angustifolia"
- Digitalis Purpurea

- Chrysanthemum Cogineum
- Armeria Montana
- Hosta Plantaginea
- Oenothera

Edged with:

- Sweet Alyssum
- Myotis Scorpioides

A bed of shrub roses:

- Bengal, Tea, Bourbon, Noisette Roses

Two beds of annuals alongside the north path:

- Blue Lobelia
- Pansies yellow & blue
- Verbena
- Lantana
- Nigella
- And Cabbage & moss roses

## Northwest Quadrant

Hedge – 4-5' Regel's Privet

Bed of shrub roses (matching east quadrant):

- Bengal, Tea, Bourbon and Noisette Roses
- 5 Climbing roses trained on supports

Two beds of annuals alongside the north path (matching east quadrant):

- Blue Lobelia
- Pansies yellow & blue
- Verbena
- Lantana
- Nigella
- Cabbage & Moss roses

Beds on the southern edge (matching beds on the south side of the west path):

- Thyme
- Mignonette
- Heliotrope Darcena

Another bed with mixed annuals:

- Canna
- Geraniums
- Petunias
